The Concert Hall

The Concert Hall is a magnificent modern hall, with perfect acoustics, suitable for various types of performance for a seated audience.

The Concert Hall has a fully equipped fly tower. Our technical team can take care of all the sound and lighting. We will quote a price for this according to the wishes of the orchestra or company involved. Basic technical services and reception staff are included in the standard hall rental fee.

Capacity

The capacity of the Concert Hall is between 1,132 and 1,289 places. Depending on the configuration of the hall, chairs can be installed in the orchestra zone (orchestra pit) or space can be made for a technical island. In the rental agreement, a standard clause specifies that 25 complimentary seats will be reserved for the Concertgebouw.

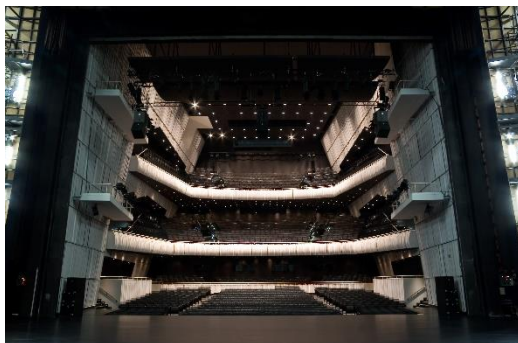
Price

The rental fee of the Concert Hall is € 6.800. (VAT Excl.) This fee covers 1 show on 1 day. For more performances an additional fee will be quoted.

For performances without a break, a bar penalty/pause buy-out of € 450 will be charged.

Included in the standard rental fee:

- Theatre hosts for ticket control, cloakroom and seat direction until 30 minutes after the show
- Use of the Concert Hall, with standard stage and seating
- Use of the FOH system (existing speakers: D&B Q-set and amplifiers)
- Gebruik aanwezig front- en tegenlicht licht voor de scène
- If required: acoustic shell, orchestra setting, stage elements
- If required: use of the orchestra pit
- Bar operated by Concertgebouw theatre hosts during the break
- Dressing rooms
- Availability of three technicians for a maximum period of 10 hours per day, assembly, dismantling, rehearsal and performance included.
- One Concertgebouw Event Manager
- Announcement of the show on the website and in the 'Concertgebouw Magazine'
- Standard lighting, cleaning and heating costs are also included.

Sound: The artist is responsible for the mixer, microphones, monitors, backline, .. and the operation of it. If desired, the Concertgebouw can provide this service. An offer will be made based on a technical rider.

Lighting: General front and backlighting is standard and can be used by the artist. Concertgebouw can provide a quotation for a more extensive lighting plan.

Catering

All the catering in the Concertgebouw is provided exclusively by the Concertgebouw, which has reached a partnership agreement to this end with a number of preferred caterers. Backstage catering can be organised by the concert organiser.
